LUGGAGE

Luggage tags are being provided to assist you in locating your luggage in the Port Canaveral Terminal. Please write your stateroom number, name, address and number of bags on these tags (e.g. 1 of 2). Remove any old airline or blue Disney tags. Attach the new tags to your luggage and place it outside your stateroom between 9:00pm and 11:00pm for complimentary delivery to the ship's terminal. Any luggage not placed outside the stateroom by 11:00pm must be hand carried by the guest when disembarking the ship. We suggest that you pack all valuables such as cash, negotiable securities or other financial instruments, gold, silver, jewelry, ornaments, works of art photographic/ video/audio equipment or supplies, laptop computers, cellular phones, breakables such as perfume & liquor, medicines or other valuables in your day bag to be kept with you throughout your journey. Your belongings will be stored and conveniently located in colored zones, according to stateroom number, for easy recognition in the port terminal. Once you locate your luggage, porters will be available to assist you as you proceed through Customs. The Transportation Security Administration suggests that all passengers, flying through U.S. airports, unlock all Checked Baggage. Baggage may be searched at any time and locks may be broken if a physical inspection is required (This will be addressed by airline personnel when accepting Guest luggage). They also suggest removing all unprocessed film and cameras with undeveloped film from your luggage.

In accordance with Federal law, **NO fresh fruits, vegetables, plant materials or meats of animal products may be brought back into the United States. Heavy fines may be imposed on guests found with these items.**

Green Palm handicrafts are discouraged for possible red mite infestation.

CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION – PASSPORT CONTROL

U.S. Customs and Border Protection requires all Non-U.S. Guests and those Guests who joined us in Nassau or Castaway Cay, to present themselves personally for inspection upon arrival into Port Canaveral. Please bring your passport receipt with you. If this applies to you, please meet in the Walt Disney Theatre, Deck 4, Forward, tomorrow morning at **6:00am**.

CUSTOMS ALLOWANCE

In accordance with United States Customs and Border Protection Regulations, please be aware of the following: It is required that one guest per family complete a U.S. Customs Declaration Form. You will receive this form on the last evening of your cruise from your Stateroom Host/Hostess.

GO WIRELESS WITH YOUR OWN LAPTOP

Connecting to the Wireless Network: Open your Internet browser to get started. You will automatically be directed to a Login page then enter your login information found below. If you are unable to connect, additional wireless information is available from Guest Services on Deck 3 Midship.

Once logged in: Select your pricing option on the screen. All applicable charges will automatically be billed to your onboard account.

Be sure to click the **LOGOUT** icon on the desktop to end your session.

LOGIN INSTRUCTIONS

Username: Enter your first initial, last name, and stateroom number, all lowercase with no spaces.
EXAMPLE: jdavis1431 (for John Davis in cabin 1431)

Password: Enter your birth date in six digit format: mmddyy
EXAMPLE: 043060 (for April 30, 1960)

New Password: The system will ask you to enter a new password. Use this new password for all future log ins.

Logout: Once you are logged in, a separate browser window will open that displays a count-down of time used. Keep this window open until you are ready to logout. If you close or lose the logout window, type **http://1.1.1.1/logout** in the address bar to manually logout and end your session. (Verify that pop-up blockers are disabled)

CONNECTING TO A WIRELESS NETWORK

If you are not able to connect by opening your browser, the following settings may need to be changed in order to facilitate wireless network access. **Please Note:** Each laptop is configured differently and changing the settings below will not guarantee you will be able to connect to a wireless network. These are general settings that need to be configured for most laptops to access a wireless environment.

Windows Users

1. Make sure you have the SSID set to "MTN-DSI":
 - a. Move the mouse over the Wireless Connection Icon on the bottom right corner of the screen. It should show: "Wireless Network Connection (mtnndsi)."
 - b. If it is not connected: right click on the Wireless Connection Icon and select "View Available Wireless Networks." Choose "mtnndsi."
 - c. Check the "Allow me to Connect" box, then click "Connect."
2. Check your Internet Settings:
 - a. Go to Start > Settings > Control Panel > Internet Options > under the "connections" tab.
 - b. Make sure "Never dial a connection" is selected in the top box.
 - c. Click on the LAN SETTINGS buttons at the bottom.
 - d. Make sure "Automatically detect settings" is checked at the top.
 - e. Make sure "Use a Proxy Server" is not checked.
3. Make sure any Firewall software you may have is disabled:
 - a. Look in the system tray (next to clock on task bar for running firewall/Internet security programs).
4. Make sure your wireless card's encryption is disabled:
 - a. Right click on the Wireless Connection Icon and select "Status." Click on "Properties" and choose the "Wireless Networks" tab. Highlight "mtnndsi." and click "Configure."
 - b. Under the "Association" tab, all boxes should not be un-checked.
5. Make sure pop-up blocker software is disabled:
 - a. Look in the system tray for popup blocker programs.
6. Make sure DHCP is enabled on the wireless card:
 - a. Go to Start > Settings > Control Panel > Network Connections.
 - b. Right click the Wireless Network Connection > Properties.
 - c. Double-Click Internet Protocol (TCP/IP).
 - d. Make sure "Obtain an IP address automatically" is selected.
 - e. Make sure "Obtain DNS server address automatically" is selected.
 - f. Click OK, click Ok.
7. Make sure SSID is turned off:
 - a. Go to Start > Settings > Control Panel > Network Connections.
 - b. Right click the Wireless Network Connection > Properties.
 - c. Click on Wireless networks tab
 - d. Click CONFIGURE.
 - e. Make sure all boxes are not checked.
8. If you are running Norton Anti-Virus, disable script blocking:
 - a. Go to Norton Anti-virus Properties.
 - b. Find the "Script Blocking" box. Be sure it is not checked.

Microsoft Outlook Users:

You may have to change the outgoing SMTP server address to 172.31.0.2 in order to send your messages. Please remember to make a note of your original address, as these will need to be reset to your original configuration when you get home.

Macintosh Users

1. Turn "Airport" on in the "Internet Connect" application.

 - e. The blue bar should now show the signal strength of the "MTN-DSI" network.

 - a. Go to the "Apple Menu" from the Menu Bar and open "System Preferences."

CONFIGURE > set to "Using DHCP"
AIRPORT TAB: select "Join network with best signal"
(or temporarily use "Join a specific network" to select or create the "MTN-DSI" network).
 - d. Click "Apply Now" button.
 - e. Restart laptop for settings to take effect.

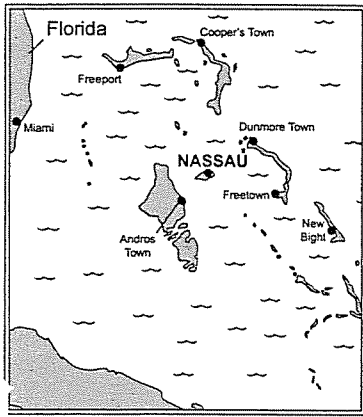

CAPITAL

Nassau is the capital of the Bahamas.

LOCATION

The Bahamas is made up of more than 700 islands and cays, beginning just 50 miles from Palm Beach, Florida, and extending over 100,000 square miles to the Windward Passage at the edge of the Caribbean Sea. Nassau is just 150 miles from the Florida coast.

SIZE

The total land area of the Bahamas is 5,358 square miles, surrounded by 100,000 square miles of water. Nassau is only 21 miles long and 7 miles wide.

POPULATION

The Bahamas has a total population of about 350,000 people. Of these, 200,000 people live in Nassau.

LANGUAGE

The official language of Nassau is English.

CURRENCY

The Bahamian dollar is the official unit of currency. U.S. dollars, travelers checks and credit cards are widely accepted.

TIME ZONE

Nassau is on Eastern Standard Time. The ship may not always follow local time. Please adhere to the ship's time while in port.

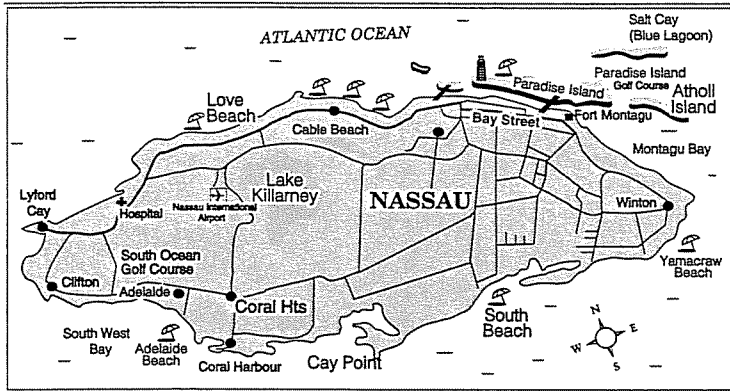

Spotlight on Nassau



HISTORY

Nassau is the capital of the Commonwealth of the Bahamas and the largest city in the Bahamas. Even though it sits on one of the smaller islands, Nassau is home to more than half of the 350,000 people who live in the Bahamas and is one of the island's most charming towns.

Nassau's history is rich with adventure. When Christopher Columbus landed in 1492, some of the Bahamas were inhabited by Lucayan Indians. The Spaniards abandoned plans to stay when they discovered there was no gold on the islands.

English Puritans from Bermuda, seeking a new way of life, came to the islands about 150 years later and settled on Eleuthera. More settlers followed.

For many years, pirates and swashbucklers dominated the waters around the archipelago. Blackbeard was among the most famous of these. Civilization was restored in the islands when in 1717, Capt. Woodes Rogers, once a pirate himself, was enlisted as governor and initiated a clean-up. He offered full amnesty to all pirates who lowered their flags. Those that refused were destroyed.

Nassau prospered and fell many times over the course of the next 200 years. Before the turn of the century, Henry Flagler came to the Bahamas with the money and power needed to build the island in to a major resort town. World War I, however, stopped travel in the Atlantic, and Nassau again suffered economic devastation.

Luckily, prohibition in the U.S. afforded the islands some unusual luck. The first casino opened in 1929 and that same year, Pan Am began service to Nassau from Miami, bringing wealthy American tourists to the island.

Today, the Bahamas is the playground of vacationers from around the world who flock to the islands in search of sandy beaches, warm waters, world-class shops and resort, and friendly locals.

LOCAL FLAVORS

Once the haven of pirates and rum runners, Nassau offers a wide variety of nautical souvenirs including authentic pirate's treasure coins, as well as delicious rums and rum products.

DOCKING/TENDERING

The ship docks in Nassau at Prince George Wharf.

SHORE EXCURSIONS

Please check your tour voucher for the correct meeting time and location for your tour. Your Shore Excursions team will direct you to your transportation.

TRANSPORTATION

The best way to explore downtown Nassau is on foot. The following fares are from the cruise ship terminal and rates are per person:

Cable Beach: \$5.00 per person
Paradise Island: \$4.00 per person plus a \$1.00 bridge toll for the cab. Water taxi to Paradise Island \$3.00 tickets for the water taxi may be purchased at the pier entrance.

HOW TO GET TO TOWN

All shops are within walking distance from the pier.

SHOPPING

Nassau is a great place for bargains, with savings on many items such as jewelry, watches, china, crystal and leather; savings from 20% to 50% below stateside retail prices.

STORE HOURS

Most stores are open Monday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Stores are open from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Sundays. Some stores will remain open until 6:00 p.m. See store descriptions for further information.

BANK HOURS

Banks are open Monday through Thursday from 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and on Friday from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

POST OFFICE HOURS

The post office is open Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

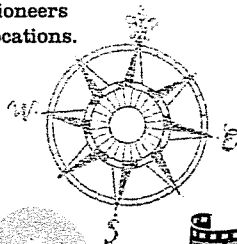
